Kristen Tomlan, founder of the new ready-to-eat cookie dough cafe, DÖ, *Cookie Dough Confections*, is taking that idea to the next level. From her love for unbaked dough, DÖ was created "to let dessert lovers eat cookie dough exactly how they crave it—straight from the mixing bowl." The colorful shop serves up safe-to-eat raw cookie dough made from scratch, with more than a dozen flavors from which to choose. Signature combinations like the Heavenly, made with Nutella, or the Confetti, made with sprinkles and chips, are standouts, and look for seasonal favorites that change every few months.
